Park in one of the numerous parking lots located at various public buildings such as **City Hall** at 9 Harrison Ave. or the nearby **Marina Civic Center** at 8 Harrison Ave. On-street parking is also plentiful throughout the area. **Downtown Panama City** encompasses the section from Oak Avenue to McKenzie Avenue and along Harrison Avenue from 11th Street to the Panama City Marina.

You can also hitch a ride on the **Bay Town Trolley**. Rolling through the town, the Bay Town Trolley takes passengers through Historic St. Andrews and Historic Downtown Panama City for \$4.00. You won't want to miss this romp through the town with informative and entertaining conductors.

WHERE TO PARK

Park near or in the lot at **Floriopolis**, 1125 Beck Ave., a community arts metropolis offering art exhibits and events. To get there from Downtown, follow Harrison Avenue north to 11th Street. Turn left (west) on 11th and continue on for about 28 blocks until you reach Beck Avenue.

OR turn left (west) off of Harrison onto 6th Street and follow it until it merges with West Beach Drive (ALT U.S. Hwy. 98). Stay on Beach Drive all the way to Frankford Avenue. Still following ALT U.S. 98, turn left off of Frankford onto West 9th Street, which dead-ends at Oaks by the Bay Park. Turn right on Chestnut Avenue and travel one block to West 10th Street. Turn left onto West 10th and proceed one more block to Beck Avenue.

Get creative at Floriopolis, a family friendly art gallery and interactive art studio. Shop for one-of-a-kind creations and relax in the inviting public art courtyard, where you can play a giant game of chess or checkers. Bring the family to take a 10-minute art break by participating in Art on the Spot, free mini art lessons disguised as fun projects that happen daily or have a Studio Day and create your own masterpiece!

Historic St. Andrews

WHERE TO PARK

Park in the parking lot located at **Oaks by the Park** at 2715 W 10th St. or across the street at the **Destination Panama City Visitors Center** at 1000 Beck Ave. There is also ample on-street parking in the area and at the **St. Andrews Marina**, 3151 W. 10th St.

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at **St. Andrews Coffee House**, 1006 Beck Ave. Perfect for the whole family, they brew a perfect cup of java along with their constantly changing breakfast specials! Take a seat in the corner nook surround by fluffy pillows and children's book's, and even a set of checkers. Bay County's oldest existing coffee house, St. Andrews Coffee House has a charming and friendly atmosphere.

Schedule a guided tour to explore Shell Island, an uninhabited barrier island stretching for 7 miles between the Gulf of Mexico and St. Andrew Bay. You're likely to catch a pod of dolphins playing in the water, and can even jump in to join the fun! Once on the island, there's endless amounts of fun to be had! Shelling, snorkeling, fishing, and maybe even a sea turtle sighting! If you prefer to take the trip with just the family, you can rent a boat or jet skis for unguided excursions or partially guided tours.

Hire an experienced fishing charter service to take the family out to the best spots where the fish are plentiful. Numerous charter boat captains can arrange for inshore and offshore fishing year-round.

Sprawling more than 68,000 acres behind the protection of the Gulf of Mexico shoreline, **St. Andrew Bay** is home to abundant aquatic life. The bay spans more than 20 miles and includes a wealth of saltwater flats and seagrass beds that offer a rich bounty. Redfish, speckled trout, black drum, cobia, sheepshead, and flounder are just a few of the species populating these channels.
